It is a parish Schools Advisory Commission policy that all St. Wendelin students wear uniforms. St. Wendelin Schools have selected uniforms by Elderwear. These are available at Custom Corner, Inc. (formerly J. Miller & Co.).

**ELEMENTARY GRADES K-6\***

6<sup>th</sup> grade is considered a transition year may follow K-6 or 6-8 uniform policies.

**GRADES 7-12**

Black cardigan & crew sweaters are being phased out\*, replaced by SW fleece.

*\*Items being phased out can be worn for as long as they are in good condition.*

The following policies will be in place for the elementary (K-6) 2009-2010 school year.

#### All Students

1. Inappropriate clothing would be clothing which is too tight, too short or inappropriately worn. Also, no ragged bottom or side seam-slit pants.
2. T-shirts/undershirts may be worn under uniform shirts. T-shirts/undershirts must be white and must be tucked in. Long sleeve t-shirts may not be worn with short sleeve uniform shirts. T-shirts cannot have writing or pictures on them.
3. All sweatshirts, jackets and outdoor clothing are to be kept in lockers during the school day. Coats cannot be worn in the classroom. Sunglasses are not permitted.
4. Any tattoo, tattoo-like drawings or body piercing (ears permitted for girls) may not be visible in any dress code outfit, physical education apparel, or athletic teams or events.
5. Head coverings are not to be worn in the building.
6. No unnatural hair coloring.
7. Socks or nylons are to be worn at all times. Thigh high stockings/knee high nylons are not permitted.
8. Shoes and short boots that are in good condition are permitted. Toes must be covered. An alternate pair of athletic shoes must be worn for gym class. Sandals are not permitted.
9. Oxford shirts must be tucked in and all shirts must be buttoned except for the top button.
10. Fad-type haircuts such as shag tops are not permitted and are judged as such by the Administration.

#### **GIRLS**

1. Earrings in ears are permitted. Any other body piercing (including tongue piercing) is prohibited.

#### **BOYS**

1. Hair length may not extend below the top of the collar and must be above the eyebrows and the earlobe. Boys will be expected to always have their hair within these guidelines. Violation could mean being sent home until the student gets a hair cut. Fad-type haircuts such as shag tops are not permitted and are judged as such by the Administration.
2. Boys will be clean-shaven. No facial hair (beards, mustaches) will be allowed. No sideburns longer than the bottom of the ear.
3. No earrings or body piercing (including tongue piercing) are permitted for boys.

**Since no dress code guidelines can take into account all circumstances, the final decision on approved dress shall rest with the Administration.**
