I was able to attend the retreat for our fraternity of priest support group this past week. We reflected on Pope Benedict's comments on what a priest is called to be. It is helpful to go back to the basics. I suppose it helps all of us whether single or married to do that i.e. reflect on why we are where we are and how we got there.

I will also have the privilege to offer mass for the JOY retreat this weekend. This is a retreat for physically handicapped people who gather once a year. I have gained many friends during these retreats (about 25 years of them) and always look forward to the weekend. Because of the Confirmation yesterday (Saturday) I wasn't able to spend the usual time with them. During the years I learned patience, patience, patience. Their speed is slower than most of us. They spend a lot of time waiting for people to help them. One of my friends once chewed me out because I didn't give her the date for the Christmas gathering. She pointed out that they needed to line up transportation two months ahead of time in order to make the gathering. Another revelation! I also learned that you talk to the person in the wheelchair not to the person who accompanies them. Being handicapped does not affect the power to speak, hear and think!

It is great to look forward to Phil's deacon ordination next Saturday. I hope you can join him in celebrating this wonderful event. You are invited for the Holy Hour on Friday night at 7 p.m. as we pray for him and the other two deacons to be ordained. It will be a grace moment for our parish. He will preach the weekend Masses on May 8 and 9. This will also be our time to say God speed to him after all the Masses. He will be moving to St. Pat's downtown in Toledo to begin his CPE, clinical Pastoral Education, at St. Vincent. This will take him through the summer. Then he returns to Rome for his final year of study. God bless him on this journey.

Lest we forget, congratulations to the 8<sup>th</sup> graders who received Confirmation at the Cathedral yesterday. Let the Spirit bring them alive! May they mature in the power of Jesus to build God's kingdom here.
