


SCHOOL NEWS

MOVING FORWARD WITH FAITH AND POSSIBILITIES

- ◆ The Wood Street playground will be moved to a grassy area just east of the old weight room.
- ◆ Updated K-12 School Operating Budget Projection
 - ◇ Staff reductions have lowered the projected deficit for 2010-2011 to approximately \$240,000, based on opening day enrollment. This is down significantly from the \$400,000 deficit previously predicted.
 - ◇ The deficit will be covered by discretionary allocation from a bequest.
 - ◇ The significant deficit reduction will extend the availability of the bequest.
- ◆ Sr. Teresita and Sr. Carolyn will be co-chairing the New Beginnings Committee and the Faith Formation Committee. The New Beginnings Committee will focus on the smooth transition and welcoming of our new K-12 students, teachers and staff at the beginning of school. The Faith Formation committee is looking for creative ways to integrate faith formation throughout grades K-12. Both committees will meet in July.
- ◆ The St. Wendelin School Strategic Plan 2010-2012
 - ◇ The plan will be completed July 12, 2010.
 - ◇ The plan focuses on three key issues
 - Determine optimal enrollment
 - Determine the curricular and extracurricular programs to comprise the St. Wendelin School experience.
 - Devise a year-round comprehensive regional marketing program.
 - ◇ The 2010-2012 Strategic Plan will be released later this summer.
- ◆ The Wood St. building is in good shape. We are looking for individuals who would like to sit on a committee to brainstorm possibilities for its use. Please reply to transition@stwendelin.org if you can help in this area.

St. Wendelin Playground—Volunteers Needed!!!

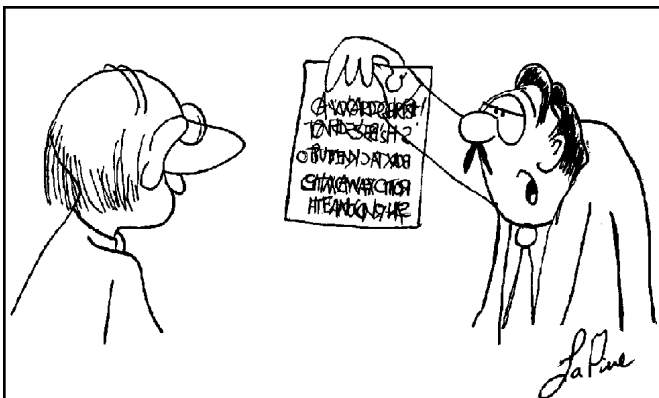
