Women, we need you!

I remember a conversation with a woman who was reflecting on her life. She grew up in the 60's and was strongly influenced by the woman's right movement. She bought into the whole competition with men and getting into the work force. She ended up with a divorce and no children. What she shared with me was the following. If I could live my life over again, I would put the family first, I would re-examine what it means to be a woman and what special gifts I could offer to the world I am living in. I made some very poor choices, now I have to live with them.

I admit, I am old fashioned. I believe that women set the moral and ethical tone for our society. I don't want to excuse us men, but I remember a conversation with my dad. "You know your mom is something else!" When I asked what he meant. He said, "When I come out dressed in a non-matching outfit, she makes me go back and change. But, you know what, if it wouldn't be for her, I would be a slob." I remember the days, when women's language was clean and it was the guys you had to correct. I would challenge our teenagers especially, to go back to those days. I thought they always had a better grasp of the language and the boys needed to work on expanding their knowledge of the English language. The women challenged the boys to purity, to keep their hands to themselves, and by their dress modeled modesty. The less exposure, the greater the mystery, is a great guide.

Women, we need your help and example. Most civilizations collapse from within because of the moral decline of their people. We are well on the way and we need you to change the direction.

God guide and give us courage.
